Please accept my regards on behalf of DNA Testing Services and our sister company Crime Scene Investigation (CSI Nairobi), East and Central Africa based investigation firms.

We are writing to you on behalf of victims of Sexual Assault Violence here in Kenya to kindly request you to assist us secure justice and closure for them from the Republic of South Korea.

Our case before South Korea was presented to President Moon Jae-in in February 2020 (this year) and we have not heard from him since. The correspondence is attached to this letter.

Mr. Prime Minister, why we are requesting for Japan's assistance in this matter is for the reason that the successive governments of Japan have had to address a similar issue presented by the South Korean victims of Sexual Assault.

The government of South Korea has relentlessly fought for these citizens' rights and Japan has had to address the matter.

It is this experience in dealing with a similar matter that we request assistance from you...in whichever form it is presented.

What fascinates us about this matter is this; that the government of South Korea has been at the international forefront in publicly demanding for justice for her citizens from Japan. However, when the tables are turned, and it is their time to secure justice for citizens of another state, the cries and tears of these other victims fall on deaf ears.


Perhaps the reason for this silence from the government of South Korea is because of the current Covid 19 pandemic.
