Democratic Republic of Congo Initiative for the use of DNA technology to Identify rapists

Goma Town and Environs

Rape statistics December 2009 – January 2010

Statistics available to CSI Nairobi from Heal Africa indicate that in December 2009 and January 2010, civilians in Eastern Congo sexually assaulted 65 women and girls. **Heal Africa** was able to collect forensic DNA evidence from 5 of the survivors. Samples were shipped to the United States, **Bode Technology Group**, for DNA analysis and profiling by **CSI Nairobi**.

Notes:

- 100% of the rape survivors were women
- 100% of DNA samples were collected from women and girls raped by civilian suspects

Statistics received from **Heal Africa** indicate:

- 62.5% of the rape survivors were women under 18 years.
- 37.5% of the rape survivors were women and girls above the age of 18 years

- 12.5% of the Minors raped were below 10 years of Age with the youngest 2 years old.
- 17.5% of rape survivors were Gang Raped, the youngest survivor being 7 years and the oldest being 53years.
- 60% of the gang rapes were perpetrated by armed groups while 40% were committed by civilians.
- 21% of the armed gang rapes were perpetrated by government soldiers and 79% by suspected Militia.
- 10% of all rape survivors were raped by government soldiers.
- The most dangerous neighborhoods for women and children are Mabanga, Masisi and Goma Town.
- The most dangerous affluent neighborhood for women and children is Milmiani.
